Your email below has reference.

At the public meeting we did agree to come and meet with you and Hennie Heyns, which we then subsequently did on 11 June 2015 along with the Eskom negotiator. The minutes of this meeting are attached and have also been included in the project records (see Final Scoping Report) of which you were notified and was made available to the public.

Your concerns are being considered in the EIR but the finalisation of the draft EIR has been delayed and as per the recent progress letter sent out will now be made available for public comment sometime in the first quarter of 2015.

Eskom does not commence with landowner negotiations until environmental authorisation has been obtained and so I don't believe any further meetings or correspondence now will change the outcomes of what was already discussed at the meeting on 11 June 2015. At the first public meeting I was promised that the Eskom representative would come and see me regarding the issue of our zoning and the fact we need to be compensated in some form as the municipality has stipulated we had to rezone to an ecotourism / green development. We complied and it took us 9 years and a great deal of money. Now that the sub station appears to be a fait accompli we are up the creek without a paddle and we will have to re-apply for a different type of development due to the nature of the ESKOM development (totally contrary to what the municipality wanted for the area). Should ESKOM not contact me within 30 days regarding this matter I shall have to refer it to our lawyers and take the necessary action to protect our interests.
