Dear Sir.

I, H.D.Heyns, am the sole director of the company, Samaria Safaris, which owns the properties, Farm Vaalkop and Dadelfontein No 885, adjacent to where the proposed Camperdown Sub-station is to be built.

I object to the building of this substation at the planned location, in the strongest possible terms.

The Local government plans for this area has always been, agriculture, residential and tourism, and Eskom's plans are in total contradiction.

For the past nine years we have been busy with our development plans, of an equestrian housing estate, now amended to an Aero and Wild Life Estate. We are in the final stage of obtaining consent to develop.

A substation of this size, and the number of power lines coming into the substation, would greatly affect the value and success of our development.

Whilst Eskom are unable to predict when all these power lines will actually be constructed, the statement may cause the Municipality to sterilize my property, pending finalization of the alignment of the servitude.

This will obviously cause me great financial hardship, and I will hold Eskom liable for any losses incurred.

Therefore , I request that Eskom either withdraw the statement or enter into negotiations, immediately, with me for any expropriation, and or compensation necessary to avoid any conflict.
