Apologies for the delayed response to your email, things always get quite busy this last week of November.

The proposed Isundu EIA application is covering the proposed sub-station and approximately 4km of 2x400 kV double circuit lines.

As far as I am aware, none of these properties are owned by ITB, but by a private individual (for the sub-station) and the Mayibuye Community Trust (for one part of the transmission line). All have been involved in the PPP process.

I have attached kml files showing the proposed sub-station location and layout and the recommended route for the transmission line.
