RE: PROPOSED ISUNDU SUB-STATION AND TURN IN TRANSMISSION LINES DEA EIA REF: 14/12/16/3/3/2/745

Your correspondence has been received by the Ingonyama Trust Board (ITB) in relation with your email dated 2nd December 2016 refers. Kindly note that the proposed project sites are not under the ownership of ITB. Should it ever be established that ITB land is being affected by the proposed project, formal agreements need to be entered into between the Ingonyama Trust Board and Eskom.

It should however be noted that the buffer distances between the Sub-Station and Transmission lines are to be adhered to and communities living in close proximity to the electrical infrastructure is to be safeguarded at all times. Should the Transmission Lines ever need to traverse via ITB Land, adequate consultation is to be undertaken with the ITB to ensure that Servitude Agreements are put in place prior to any construction work being embarked on.
