Dear Annah, Aldine

As per the outcomes of yesterday's meeting, the following process of engagement was agreed upon between the parties:

1. RCL to submit a letter to Eskom by 22 July, with an indication of the additional information /studies required from Eskom.
2. Eskom to respond to RCLs letter by 31 July and the parties to agree on the process of negotiation on a way forward.
3. Eskom and RCL have agreed to suspend the administration of the appeal in respect of the transmission lines until 31 October 2016.
4. Both RCL and Eskom to submit supplementary grounds of appeal and responding statements, should the process of negotiation not result in a resolution of the appeal.

Whilst I note that the issues in respect of the aforementioned appeal and that of the substation (which application is yet to be granted by the Department) are, to a large extent interrelated, the parties are reminded that discussions in respect of the substation and objections thereto are premature at this stage and should be raised at the appropriate forum.
