Thank you for your telephone call this morning. In response to your inquiry, in Section 13: Environmental Impact Statement (of the Final EIAR), paragraph 3 reads as follows (my underlining):

The proposed Isundu site is considered the most feasible site out of more than 25 alternative sites identified since Eskom commenced investigations in late 2008. Of the two layout alternatives assessed, Layout 2 is the recommended layout as it reduces the impact of the proposed and future transmission lines on the Mayibuye development to the south of the P477.

Section 4.5: Layout Alternatives, simply describes the two alternatives without offering an opinion on which is recommended because the following sections of the report are required first, as they provide the rationale/arguments as to how we (as EAP) arrived at Layout 2 being the recommended alternative (in Section 13).
