SANRAL is responsible for improving, managing and maintaining the network of national roads which act as the “economic arteries” of South Africa. Sections of the N2 and N3 are operating at full capacity and traffic studies indicate a need to upgrade them to accommodate future growth and improve road safety. SANRAL (Eastern Region) thus plans to provide additional lanes along a section of the N2 in Durban and along the N3 between Durban and Cedara.

The project requires environmental authorisation from the national Department of Environmental Affairs as it triggers various activities listed in the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, published under National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (NEMA) (Act No. 107 of 1998) (as amended).

SANRAL has appointed ACER (Africa) Environmental Consultants to undertake the application for environmental authorisation, which requires the preparation of a Basic Assessment Report, inclusive of a technical investigation and public participation.

ACER, on behalf of SANRAL, will also submit a Water Use Licence Application to the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS), in accordance with Section 21 of the National Water Act (Act No. 36 of 1998), as amended.
