DRAFT BASIC ASSESSMENT REPORT 1 FOR REVIEW AND COMMENT

Notice is hereby given in terms of the amended EIA Regulations (2017) published under the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998), as amended, of the availability of the Draft Basic Assessment Report for the above-mentioned project.

The South African National Roads Agency SOC Limited (SANRAL) is proposing capacity upgrades to the N2 and N3 between Durban and Pietermaritzburg, to accommodate future traffic growth, increase mobility and improve road safety.

The Draft Basic Assessment Report (BAR) and Environmental Management Programme (EMPr) for **Basic Assessment 1** deals with proposed capacity upgrades to the N2 (Solomon Mahlangu Interchange (I/C) to south of Umgeni Road/I/C), including expansion of EB Cloete and Solomon Mahlangu Interchanges, and the N3 (EB Cloete to Paradise Valley) including provision of temporary access for construction below Westville and Paradise Valley viaducts, and realignment of a Transnet Fuel Pipeline in the vicinity of the N2 Solomon Mahlangu interchange.

The Draft BAR and EMPr for **Basic Assessment 1** will be made available for public review and comment during the statutory 30-day commenting period between **11 October 2018 and 9 November 2018** (inclusive), at the following public libraries:

The proposed development also requires water use authorisation from the Department of Water and Sanitation under the provisions of a General Authorisation. These documents form part of the suite of documents available for public review.
