Notice is hereby given in terms of the amended EIA Regulations (2017) published under the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998), as amended, of the availability of the Draft Basic Assessment Report for the above-mentioned project.

The South African National Roads Agency SOC Limited (SANRAL) is proposing capacity upgrades to the N2 N2 and N3 between Durban and Pietermaritzburg, to accommodate future traffic growth, increase mobility and improve road safety.

The Draft Basic Assessment Report (BAR) and Environmental Management Programme (EMPr) for **Basic Assessment 5** primarily deals with the proposed capacity upgrades between Lynnfield Park and Gladys Manzi (formerly Murray) Road.
