Thank you Elaine and Sonja

May we clarify/confirm further in order to understand how best to respond to Mkhambatini's comments:

1. SANRAL sites for stockpiling etc require EIA & Rezoning (Camperdown I/C & Lynnfield Park) – **does this refer to the Ptn 187 of the Farm Vaalkop & Dadelfontein No.885?**
2. Erf 106 Camperdown is not supported for stockpiling of rubble/fill because of wetlands/dam and impact on the urban area. **Is this RE/106 on the cadastral map you sent through?**
3. Site Development Plan required for Lynnfield Park site to assess impact on adjoining Mayibuye Game reserve. **Does this refer to a development plan for the Ptn 187 of the Farm Vaalkop & Dadelfontein No.885?**
4. Rehabilitation plan required. **Does this refer to a rehabilitation plan for the Ptn 187 of the Farm Vaalkop & Dadelfontein No.885?site development plan mean the proposed layout of the Lynnfield Interchange?**
5. Reference to the Mkhambatini Urban Scheme must be made. **Please elaborate in what context – just general, like the SDF, or in relation to something specific?**
6. Clarify statement of those “formal households” which are to be relocated.

Hi Ashleigh

We are referring to the 136ha property (Ptn 187 of the Farm Vaalkop & Dadelontein No.885) recently purchased by SANRAL which lies between the Umlaas Road and Lynnfield Park interchanges, alongside the N3. The new Big 5 Game Reserve (Mayibuye) shares a common boundary with this site. The implication that it may be used for stockpiling of rubble, quarrying etc needs to be assessed as part of a NEMA application and a change of land use planning application. It is currently agricultural land. I will forward the outline of the Mayibuye game reserve to you under a separate email – the area is shown in yellow with a black border (approx. 5000ha).

With respect to question number 3, please note that the Lynnfield Park Interchange itself was dealt with as part of Basic Assessment 5, which has already gone through the commenting process and final documents have been submitted to the Department of Environmental Affairs. Site plans have previously been sent to Elaine Donaldson at Mkhambatini municipality.

However, if you can send through kml files showing the boundary of the Mayibuye Game Reserve, we can add that to our maps so that you can see the location of the reserve in relation to Lynnfield, Dardanelles and Camperdown interchanges.
