Notice is hereby given in terms of the amended EIA Regulations (2017) published under the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998), as amended, of the availability of the Draft Basic Assessment Report for the above-mentioned project.

The Draft Basic Assessment Report (BAR) and Environmental Management Programme (EMPr) for **Basic Assessment 4** deals primarily with the proposed capacity upgrades between Cato Ridge and Lynnfield Park. This Basic Assessment is being undertaken by Metamorphosis in collaboration with ACER Environmental Consultants (ACER). ACER is managing public participation aspects on behalf of Metamorphosis.

The Draft BAR and EMPr for **Basic Assessment 4** will be made available for public review and comment during the statutory 30-day commenting period between **13 March 2019 – 12 April 2019** (inclusive), at the following public libraries:
