**Subject:** Proposed Mtunzini WWTW

Morning Mr. Stegen,

Our conversation earlier this morning has reference as does the Background Information Document you will receive from my colleague Carina Boonzaaier.

As discussed ACER have been appointed to undertake the environmental authorisation for the proposed new Waste Water Treatment Works (WWTW) for Mtunzini. It is currently proposed that the outlet for the WWTW will follow the drainage line through your farm (as discussed the section adjacent to the municipal land currently farmed by Grant Lawrie) before entering the uMlalazi River.


An *Aquatic Impact Assessment* is required as one of the specialist studies for the assessment of the proposed project. This is required to determine what impacts, if any, the proposed project will have on the aquatic ecology downstream of the proposed WWTW. In this regard I would like to request permission for the aquatic specialist to access your land at some stage over the next two weeks. The specialist will require a single day for the assessment and will involve a walk down of the drainage line and the taking of water samples. Prior to the specialist accessing the land I will request that he make contact with you.
