Notice is hereby given that on 17 April 2019, the Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) granted Environmental Authorisation for SANRAL's proposed capacity upgrades of the N3 from EB Cloete Interchange to Paradise Valley and the N2 (Solomon Mahlangu Interchange to south of Umgeni Road), within the eThekweni Metropolitan Municipality, KwaZulu-Natal. This notice is issued in terms of the amended EIA Regulations (2017) published under the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998).
