SMEC has been appointed by SANRAL for the CONSULTING ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE DETAILED DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION MONITORING OF THE UPGRADE OF 11.1KM ON NATIONAL ROUTE 3 FROM MARIANHILL TOLL PLAZA, SECTION 1 (KM 25.0), TO KEY RIDGE, SECTION 2 (KM 2.8).

They will be working in association with Eyethu Engineers on the project. One of their critical path items is the drilling investigation at the Umhlatazana viaduct and they are aware of the D'MOSS area adjacent to the N3 in the vicinity of the viaduct.

In light of the discussions at our previous meeting in March, we would like to request a joint site visit to this viaduct to find an access solution. We would very much appreciate this on 1, 2, or 3 July – unfortunately as Barry is going away we are very confined to these dates.
