The property I own is 131 Entabeni Road Sarnia (Portion 1 of ERF 231 of Pinetown EXT 6).

My concern is that, with all the heavy earthmoving equipment that will be employed during the proposed upgrade, there will be a great risk of subsidence (our house is on the hill and extremely close to the N3 /M13 convergence.) I don't wish to assume anything so would appreciate confirmation that the necessary retaining wall will form part of the construction process in order to prevent any damage to the foundation and structure of the home.
